Admission Procedure

Effective 1st October 2019

Applicants for the Diploma in Screenwriting will need to submit a detailed application form, a writing sample and a nonrefundable registration fee of Rs. 250. Applicants will be screened on the quality of their writing sample and those selected for admission will be notified via email.

Admission confirmation:

On receipt of the selection notice, the candidate must proceed to deposit the fees as detailed below to secure their admission for the said batch. In addition to the fee, the candidate needs to email the scanned copy of the below-listed documents to ashwini@anupamkhercompany.com

1. One passport-size photograph.
2. Identification and permanent address proof (Passport/Adhaar Card)
3. Signed Student Declaration form

Note: The Student Declaration form also includes a Parent consent letter. While the declaration needs to be signed by students of all ages, the consent letter is to be signed only by the parents of those students who are 18 years of age and below.

1. Payment credit proof

In the case the above admission formalities is not completed within 7 days of the dispatch of the selection via email by the institute, their seat will be offered to the next in line without prior intimation to the candidate.

Fee details:

Total, when paid in full: ₹70,000 (seventy Thousand inclusive of GST)

Total, when paid in installments: ₹ 75,000 (seventy five Thousand inclusive of GST)

Note: Tuition fees and other dues shall be paid by the due date failing which there will be a penalty of Rs 500 per day up to a maximum of 3 days. Any delays beyond this will result in the student not being allowed to attend classes till the simultaneous payment of the principal fee and the accrued Rs 500 per day fine from the date of nonpayment of the fee on the due date.
